Dear Karl:

We are pleased to tell you that amateur radio operators who are repeater owners or remote base owners--who had been charged business rates--may now be eligible for residential rates from GTE. This will save these customers money on their monthly phone bill.

GTE is making this change retroactive to October 1, 1989. Amateur radio operators with these special installations, who are GTE customers, should receive a call from their GTE customer representative who will explain the change, as well as their new monthly service rate. Soon after, affected customers will notice a one-time credit on their phone bill. The change from business to residential service will be made free of any service charge.

Any amateur radio operator who does not receive a call by January 30 should contact their local business office.

This policy for amateur radio operators who are repeater owners or remote base owners will apply to all GTE telephone operating companies across the country.

GTE would like to take this opportunity to thank the members of your organization for the service they provide in their communities, especially during disasters like the recent San Francisco area earthquake.
